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РАБОТА С ФИЛЬМОМ «МОЛОДАЯ ВИКТОРИЯ» НА УРОКАХ АНГЛИЙСКОГО ЯЗЫКА

Пояснительная записка

Данный курс предназначен для тех, кто имеет знание базового английского языка. Задачей курса является дальнейшее совершенствование навыков аудирования, расширение словарного запаса, развитие разговорных навыков на основе аутентичных фильмов на английском языке. Пособие знакомит учащихся с широким кругом проблем, связанных с историей Англии.

Данное пособие поможет учащимся научиться составлять самостоятельные устные темы и письменные ответы по данной тематике. Оно приучит учащихся к работе, построенной на принципах тестирования.

Система заданий позволяет научить читателей рассмотрению темы, её обсуждению, доказательству своей точки зрения. Упражнения содержат максимальное количество современных терминов и единиц вокабуляра, что, несомненно, должно обогатить словарный запас учащихся, способствовать закреплению ранее изученной лексики.

Материалы содержат различные цифры и факты, которые представляют интерес, как для учащихся, так и для педагогов. Мы надеемся, что все это сделают занятия не только полезными, но и увлекательными.

Методические рекомендации.

Проводить работу с фильмом рекомендуется по частям (6 частей по 15 мин).

- 1. Каждая часть состоит из 3 этапов (задания на предвосхищение видеотекста, просмотр сюжета с одновременным поиском языковой информации и после текстовый этап на развитие коммуникативных умений)
- 2. Упражнения и задания следует выполнять в том порядке, в котором они располагаются (от простого к сложному).
- 3. Упражнения, отмеченные знаком «*» рекомендуется выполнять в письменной форме.
- 4. Упражнения, отмеченные знаком «!» являются повышенной сложности.
