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КОНСПЕКТ ОТКРЫТОГО УРОКА В ЧЕТВЁРТОМ КЛАССЕ ПО ТЕМЕ:  
«ОБЩИЕ И СПЕЦИАЛЬНЫЕ ВОПРОСЫ»

**Цель:** учить учащихся задавать общие и специальные вопросы в прошедшем времени.

**Задачи:** 1. Развивать умения и навыки устной речи, употребляя прошедшее время.

2. Развивать умения и навыки в чтении:

- учить читать про себя и полностью понимать текст, построенный на знакомом языковом материале;
- учить восстанавливать текст, вставляя в него глаголы в прошедшем времени.

3. Познакомить учащихся с образованием общего и специальных вопросов в прошедшем времени.

4. Познакомить учащихся с произведением детского фольклора (стихотворением).

1. Hello! I'm glad to see you! Today we have a lot of guests. Let's turn to them and say "Hello".

2. Today we have an unusual lesson. We have three teams: "The first", "The second" and "The third". Every team has to choose a captain.

- Who will be your captain? Speak each other.



- The best team will get presents.

3. Our aim is to learn to ask so many questions as you can. First, answer my questions, please.

- What date is it today?
- What date will be tomorrow?
- What date was yesterday?
- What day of the week is it today?
- What day of the week will be tomorrow?
- What day of the week was yesterday?

4. - What grammar tense did we begin to study? (Past Simple).

- What groups of the verbs do you know? (Regular verbs and irregular verbs).

- What do you know about regular verbs in Past Simple? (В прошедшем времени к ним добавляется окончание –ed, которое читается по-разному).

/t/ watched, washed, worked, danced;

/d/ smiled, cried, answered, watered;

/id/ wanted, skated, invited, collected.

- What signal words in Past Simple do you know? Look at the poster and name them. (Yesterday, the day before yesterday, three days ago, a week ago, a month ago, last year, last winter).

5. a) I say the verbs in Present Simple. Your task is to say these words in Past Simple.

1. “The first team”: see, go, have, catch, come, put.
2. “The second team”: say, fly, fall, make, draw, sing.
3. “The third team”: do, take, give, be, meet, tell.

b) - Look at the blackboard. You see the verbs in Present Simple. I'll give you some cards. Find these verbs in Past Simple and put it on the blackboard.



d) - Open your textbooks on p.57 ex. 24. I'll give you pieces of paper. Take your pens and write the questions beginning from did.


